Animal Requirements	Market goats should be 6-8 months old at time of fair check-in and must have all milk teeth intact. Youth may show and sell a dairy wether or meat-type wethers or does. Dairy wethers must be 100% dairy breeding. All wethers must be castrated by pre-fair tag-in. Goats weighing less than 50 pounds or more than 120 pounds at Fair weigh-in may be shown in designated market classes and in showmanship but may not compete for champions and may not be sold in the Livestock Sale. Market goats do not have to be dehorned.	Does must be at least 50% meat goat breed; does 24 months and older must show evidence of having kidded. Does may not be shown in breeding and market classes in the same year. Does may be horned.	Goats must be a recognized dairy goat breed. All dairy goat exhibitors must wear white in the show ring. Does must be dehorned or disbudded.
