<b>Quality Assurance</b>	Exhibitor must successfully test out of QA (ages 12 and older) or attend and complete qualifying quality assurance training. <b>Skillathons</b> <i>Required for all 4-H livestock projects. <b>Fair Rules: Animal Requirements</b>	Market lambs should be 6-8 months old at time of fair weigh-in and must have all milk teeth intact. Youth may show and sell wether or ewe lambs. <b>All wethers must be castrated by pre-fair tag-in.</b> Lambs weighing less than 95 pounds or more than 140 pounds at Fair weigh-in may be shown in designated market classes and in showmanship but may not compete for champions and may not be sold in the Livestock Sale. Market lambs will be shown in three divisions of two to three classes each. Each class shall have 6-8 lambs at the discretion of management. If there are 54 or more entries, there will be nine classes, three in each division. All market lambs <i>must</i> be slick-sheared by the fair weigh-in	Classes include: Breeding ewes born after January 1 and Breeding ewes born before January 1. Recognized breeds and crossbreeds will be eligible to show.
<b>Health Requirements</b>	No health papers required. However, <u>USDA scrapie tags</u> are required at Tag-in. forms are to be turned in at the fair weigh in.	No health papers are needed but <u>USDA scrapie tags</u> are required. Animals should show no evidence of disease, and state health rules apply.
