Equine Ambassadors Duties

- 1. Present awards during horse shows at the Adams County Fair if/when possible.
- 2. Stall at least one horse at the fairgrounds throughout the fair; return the stall banner to the 4-H Horse Committee at the end of the fair.
- 3. Assist with award presentations during the Ohio State Fair horse show if/when possible.
- 4. All ambassadors are encouraged to participates in riding horses in at least three (3) of the following local festival parades. AS A GROUP ONLY, you may ride in open car or truck or other vehicle if unable to ride on horseback, should extenuating circumstances arise, such as death, injury or illness to person or equine. The committee will make a determination of required showing.
 - A. West Union 4th of July Parade
 - B. Adams County Fair Parade
 - C. Manchester Kinfolk Landing Days Parade
 - D. Winchester Caramel Festival Parade
 - E. Rarden White Tail Deer Festival
 - F. Ripley Southern Ohio Farm Festival (replaces Tobacco Festival)
 - G. River Days (Portsmouth)
 - H. Bentonville Fall Festival Parade
 - I. Peebles Old Timers Days Festival Parade
 - J. Seaman Fall Festival Parade
 - K. Brown County Fair (Parade/Open Shows)
 - L. Maysville Christmas Parade
- 5. Attendance and work may be request for some of the following 4-H/FFA events:
 - A. Any horse committee fund raiser (including tack sales, auctions, shows) Required!
 - B. Adams County Jr Fair Beef BBQ First Thursday evening in September Expected!
 - C. 1st year horse safety and ethics clinics
 - D. 4-H Officers Training (if requested)
 - E. FFA banquets (if requested)
 - F. 4-H Recognition Program (if requested)
 - G. Radio interviews during the Adams County Fair (if requested)
 - H. Present awards at open horse shows (if needed) at Adams County Fair or other venues
 - I. Kindergarten Ag Day (May)
 - J. Ambassadors are encouraged to attend horse committee meetings and will be accorded voting rights if they apply for membership.
- 6. Polos must be worn on a regular basis at the Adams County Fair and AT ALL TIMES serving as an Equine Ambassador. Stall Banner must be prominently displayed at Adams County Fair and at Ohio State Fair Horse Show.
- 7. Dress Code is to be followed at all times, refer to Rules and Qualifications.
