

Adams County 4-H Advisory Committee

The purpose of the Adams County 4-H Advisory Committee shall be to advise Extension staff, to assess the needs of the county's youth and to plan and conduct programming to meet those needs, assist in developing 4-H program policies and procedures, help plan and conduct 4-H events and activities to further the purpose of 4-H, plan and conduct fund raisers to provide necessary program funds, evaluate the county's 4-H program, and serve as a liaison between The Ohio State University Extension, 4-H groups, and the community.

The committee meets on the third Monday of each month at 7:00 p.m. in the large conference room of the Adams County Government Center with several exceptions, which will be noted as the year progresses.

Advisors are given the opportunity to apply for the 4-H Advisory Committee each calendar year for a three-year term. The application is due to the Extension Office by September 1.

Four youth representatives will be appointed to the Committee each year for one-year terms. Two of these representatives will be junior members (ages 8-13) and two will be senior members (ages 14-18). If there are not enough applicants to fill the seat for each age range, youth members of either age can be appointed to fill those seats.

All members are expected to attend the regularly scheduled meetings, participate actively in discussion and decision-making, fulfill the duties of any office to which they are elected, and serve actively on at least two of the several subcommittees.
