

# 4-H CLUB BOOTHS, FAIR PARADE, EDUCATIONAL DISPLAY

## **Booth Information:**

- ✿ All 4-H club booths will be in the Merchants Hall Annex (Jr Fair Exhibit Building).
- ✿ Judging will be on Sunday of the fair at 10:00 a.m. The top five 4-H booths will be named Overall Outstanding Booths based on the Jr. Fair Booth Score Card: Workmanship—25 points, Appearance—25 points, Use of theme—25 points, and 4-H message—25 points.
- ✿ Premiums are \$20.00 for regular booths and \$30.00 for top five overall booths
- ✿ Each booth **must contain the projects or representation of the projects (see project guidelines for specific requirements)** of each of the members enrolled in the club, except projects that are exhibited elsewhere on the fairgrounds.
- ✿ Booth size varies, but each booth is approximately 8" wide by 4' deep.
- ✿ Booths must be **completed by 9 a.m. Sunday** (first day of fair) and left in place until 4 p.m., or one hour after the conclusion of the sale, on Saturday. Premium will be forfeited if the booth is taken down early. Booths may be set up prior to the fair on Friday from noon - 9 p.m. and Saturday, 9 a.m. - 9 p.m. The building will be closed and locked each evening.
- ✿ Members in 4-H clubs that do not have a club booth in the building **MUST exhibit their non-livestock projects in the space provided for these projects by Junior Fair Board** in order to receive their premiums and awards and maintain their eligibility to participate in State Fair. **Projects must be on display by 9:00 a.m. Sunday and may be picked up between 6-7 p.m. on Saturday.** Arrangements to pick up projects after 7 p.m. Saturday must be made with the Extension Office on the Monday after the Fair.

## **Fair Parade Information:**

- ✿ 4-H clubs are encouraged to participate in the Fair Parade on Sunday afternoon, opening day of the Fair.
- ✿ Parade line-up begins at 2 p.m. in the parking lot of the old hospital building. The parade begins at 3 p.m.
- ✿ Floats and mounted units are released after they've passed out of the center ring and into the designated area located below the horse barns.
- ✿ Junior Fair **floats** will be judged: 1<sup>st</sup> place: \$50; 2<sup>nd</sup> place: \$30; 3<sup>rd</sup> place: \$25. All other entries (mounted units of five or more youth and so on) will receive a premium of \$20.

## **Educational Display:**

- ✿ If your club chooses not to do a booth or participate in the parade, your club **MUST create an educational display.**
- ✿ This display must be **completed and displayed by 9 a.m. Sunday** (first day of fair) and left in place until 4 p.m., or one hour after the conclusion of the sale, on Saturday.
- ✿ Contact the Extension Office to discuss the location planned for your display.
- ✿ The 4-H Educator must approve the location before you can begin setting up your display.
