

Adams County 4-H Small Animal Committee Application

The Adams County 4-H Small Animal Committee is composed of up to 15 members who are either screened and approved 4-H volunteers or 4-H members enrolled in one of the three project areas: Poultry, Rabbits, and Goats. There shall be up to five (5) members representing each of the three project areas. The purpose of this group is to promote and encourage interest in the 4-H Small Animal projects and assist in planning and evaluating the small animal activities throughout the year, including coordinating the small animal shows and sales at the Fair.

The 4-H Small Animal Committee is a subcommittee of the Adams County 4-H Advisory Committee. The Committee will have openings for five or more new members each calendar year. The term of service for adults is three years and for youth is one year. Completed applications must be returned to the Extension Office by 4:00 p.m. on September 30, with members elected at the Committee's annual meeting in January.
