SOACDF Meeting Dates

The Southern Ohio Agricultural and Community Development Foundation has announced the dates for the 2018-2019 informational meetings for opportunities to apply for grants and educational assistance. The SOACDF or better known by some as the "Ag Foundation" or the "Tobacco Foundation" has been providing opportunities for educational assistance, as well as diversification and expansion in farming operations since shortly after the Master Settlement Agreement with the several States and Tobacco Companies in 1998.

If you have looked at this in the past and was not eligible for funding, you may want to check into some of the changes in qualifications. These programs have evolved over the last 20 or so years. At one time you had to have a history of either raising tobacco or owning a tobacco quota. That is one change, but there are more.

To find out about the rules or requirements for applying in 2018-2019 you are encouraged to attend one of two local meetings the first week of July. The first meeting will be in the gym at Cherry Fork on July 3 at 6:30 p.m. The second meeting will be in Georgetown at the Southern Hills Career and Technical Center Board Office on Hamer Road at 10:30 a.m.

If these dates do not work into your schedule call 937-393-2700 with questions. There are also a couple of dates for one on one visits. Those dates are July 18 in Adams County at the FSA office from 9:00 a.m. until 11:00 a.m. and in the Brown County Extension Office on July 19 from 1:00 p.m. until 3:00 p.m.
